Draped along the greatest heights of the Himalayas, Nepal is where the ice cold of the mountains meets the unrelenting heat of the Indian plains. It's a land of yetis and yaks, Sherpas and stupas and probably the best trekking on earth. Nepal is also the world's only Hindu Kingdom - it is recognized as the national religion. When less than 2% of the population consider themselves Christian, Nepal is a harvest field just waiting for laborers.

Before 1960, no Christian was officially allowed to live in the country of Nepal. By 1990, there was a measure of religious freedom to worship, but not to proselytize. Foreign mission workers play a remarkable supportive role in improving health, agriculture and education.

This will be a TREKKING trip. Teams to Nepal will trek to villages on the way to Everest in the Himalayan mountains. The team will have a strong evangelism and discipleship focus. With 80% of Nepal's population dependent on agriculture, many people live in underdeveloped areas—there is a great need for people to teach basic hygiene, teach English, disciple through Bible teaching, minister to women, and reach out to the children. We will also do ministry through medical missions. There is a need for medical professionals and nonmedical members. Medical missions brings people out who are Hindu and Buddhist and we have the opportunity to minister to them. We work alongside our contacts to develop churches in this mountain villages.
